


49% of church leaders describe their prayer life as either an add-on to their job and/or mundane





How many minutes do you allot in your worship service specifically designated for focused, participatory corporate prayer?


How often during your average year is there a call for the whole church to gather and pray?




76% say at least 7+ minutes during every weekend worship service
